Volunteers will help in creating awareness about bowel cancer and encourage more African Hackney residents to undertake bowel cancer screening

The Community African Network (CAN) received a grant from the NHS City and Hackney CCG to pilot a new approach to increasing the awareness of bowel cancer and the uptake of bowel cancer screening in the older Black African community through targeted outreach and working with GP surgeries in low uptake areas in Hackney.



Commitments:

- **Give 10 months of your time**
- **Chat with patients on the phone from a GP surgery once every fortnight**
- **DBS check (ONLY for volunteers visiting GP surgeries)**
- **Chat with people during outreach with other volunteers.**
- **Be available to attend at least one training session.**

Benefits include:

- **Access to free training opportunities**
- **Work experience and new skills**
- **Lunch and travel expenses**
